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BACKGROUND

Australian Taekwondo Queensland (ATQ), as part of its Strategic Plan 2020-2021, is responsible for delivering services to Regional Queensland.

ATQ receives funding via the Active Industry Fund of the Department of Housing and Public Works. A key deliverable under the category of physical activity participation is to promote, develop and delivery regional programs. ATQ is committed to supporting participation in taekwondo and the growth of taekwondo membership in regional Queensland.

Australian Taekwondo (AT) currently offers membership packages to taekwondo clubs at the commencement of each calendar year. A member of ATQ must first be a member of AT. ATQ recognises that many regional clubs have few members and the cost of AT membership is often prohibitive. This results in these clubs not joining AT and therefore, under our constitution, unable to join ATQ.

PURPOSE

This policy is to provide clear guidelines for regional taekwondo clubs of Queensland applying for funding from Australian Taekwondo Queensland.

SCOPE

This policy applies to:

- Head Instructors who are financial members of AT; and
- Full members of ATQ; and
- Work in taekwondo centres operating > 300km from ATQ Office Sports House, 150 Caxton Street, Milton, 4064

This policy does not apply to:

- Head Instructors who are not members of AT and/or ATQ

POLICY

ATQ will deliver financial assistance to regional clubs in the form of a \$500 grant in the 2021 calendar year. The purpose of this grant is to assist regional clubs to pay AT annual membership and subsequently annual membership of ATQ to increase ATQ's membership numbers.

A maximum of six (6) clubs will receive the grant per annum. Only one grant will be issued to each AT Head Instructor member. The ATQ Board will consider all completed applications at a date to be advised and will notify applicants and issue the grant within four weeks from that date.

Applicants must be:

- a taekwondo club operating >300 kilometres from ATQ Office (This includes New South Wales clubs eligible to be ATQ members)
- a financial member of AT
- a financial member of ATQ
- active supporters of ATQ and encourage students to be ATQ members
- the holder of an Australian Business Number

Applicants must complete the ATQ Regional Grant Application Form. See attached.
